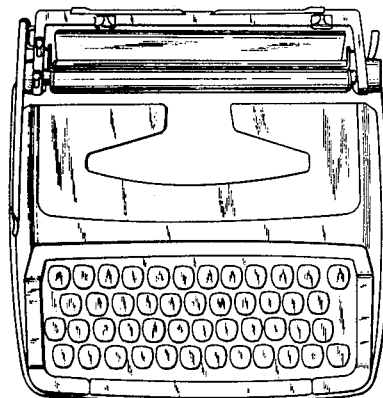
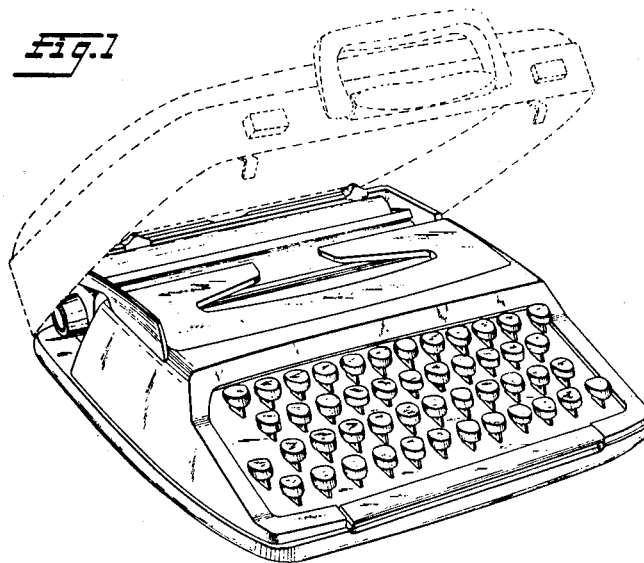

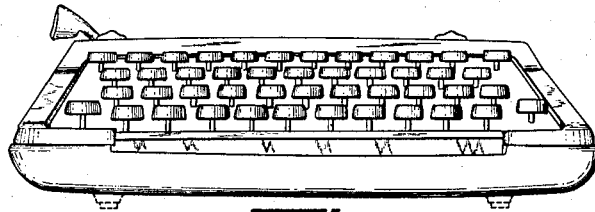

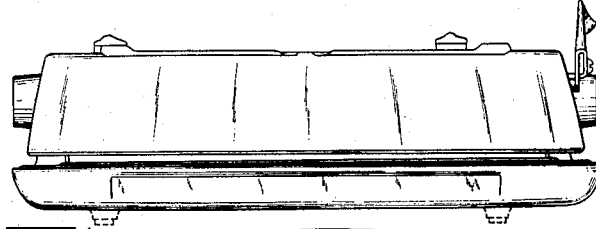

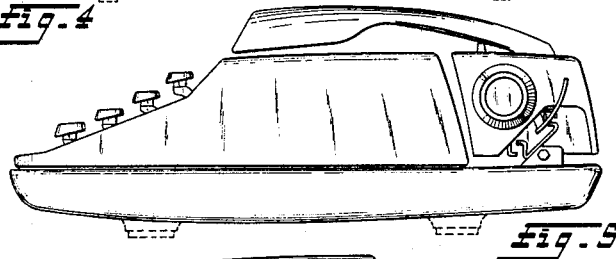

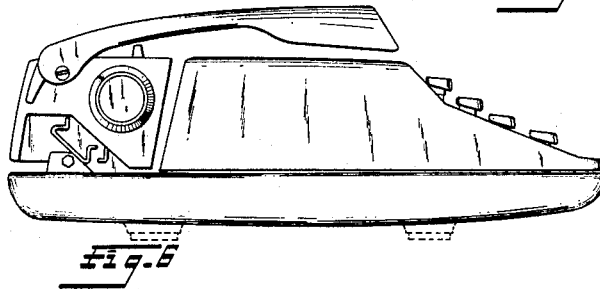

FIGURE 1 is a front perspective view of a portable typewriter embodying our new design, the cover therefor being shown in broken lines for illustrative purposes; FIGURE 2 is a top plan view thereof as it appears with the cover removed;

FIGURE 3 is a front elevational view; FIGURE 4 is a rear elevational view; FIGURE 5 is a right side elevational view; and FIGURE 6 is a left side elevational view thereof.

The combination being characterized by the solid line showing of the portable typewriter of the type disclosed having a bottom enclosing carrying case base of smoothly tapered exterior surfaces substantially merging with the sides, front and back of the typewriter near the bottom thereof providing a shaped circumferential offset away

from the typewriter so as to receive the carrying case lid of FIGURE 1, as shown.

We claim:

The ornamental design for a portable typewriter, substantially as shown and described.
